

## **Shooting by minors under supervision**

Minors between the ages of 14 and 17, may be allowed to practise shooting under supervision. Permits for Target Shooting Licence B are issued only by the Police Department. As part of the application documents, the applicants would need to attach a letter of no objection from SportMalta.

Parents/guardians of minors wishing to start practicing shooting as a sport, are to enrol the minor as member of either the Malta Shooting Sport Federation or any club which is fully registered and compliant with SportMalta.

In order for SportMalta to be able to issue the letter of no objection, the following requirements are to be submitted:

- an original letter by the Malta Shooting Sport Federation or any shooting club/range which is fully registered and compliant with SportMalta, stating:
  - that the minor is a member of its organization;
  - the shooting courses the minor is participating in;
  - that it will be responsible for the minor during coaching
  - the name of the parent/guardian who will be responsible for the minor
- copy of ID Card of minor – minor needs to be over 14 years of age and under 18 years of age
- copy of ID Card of parent/guardian of minor who will be responsible for minor during the validity of the permit
